- No pro or ICF boats
  - Ages 10 & older, younger than 18 with an adult
  - No riders not paddling in race. Maximum two people per boat.
  - Prior experience is mandatory.
  - Life jackets must be worn at all times or racer will be disqualified. No inflatable life jackets. No Type II life jackets.
  - All canoes and kayaks must be registered with the state of Ohio as ODNR Parks & Watercraft may inspect boats.
  - Lake Metroparks reserves the right to cancel, postpone or alter the race for the safety of all racers and spectators.
  - Grand River Canoe Livery: 440-813-0413 & 800-ME-CANOE, Raccoon Run Livery: 440-990-0420 [canoeraccoonrun.com](http://canoeraccoonrun.com)
  - Race directors reserve the right to combine or eliminate classes.
  - Shuttle provided to and from start to finish lines; runs 7:30 am to 2:30 pm (or race completion). Racers only—no transportation for boats.
- Face masks are required while riding shuttle.**

### NOVICE CANOE

- Novice A (combined age of 65 or younger)
- Novice B (combined age of 66 & older)

Novice classes are open to aluminum and plastic canoes. Novice racers are individuals who have never placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any race longer than five miles.

### PLEASURE CANOE

- Pleasure (all canoes, non-racing type)
- Over & Under (one participant is age 15 or younger, the other participant is at least 18 years older than the first.)
- Coed
- Master (age 40 and older; 10 second handicap will be deducted for every year over 40)

### KAYAK CLASSES

- Women's Solo Kayak (all kayaks):  
Ages 29 & younger    Ages 40 to 49    Ages 60 & older  
Ages 30 to 39    Ages 50 to 59
- Men's Down River Kayak longer than 14 ft.:  
Ages 34 & younger    Ages 35 & older
- Men's Kayak 14 ft. & shorter:  
Ages 29 & younger    Ages 40 to 49    Ages 60 & older  
Ages 30 to 39    Ages 50 to 59
- Double Kayak (All)
- Non-conforming class\*
